Theoretical Background & proposals

- I. Street Art as an individual choice of style and movement of the artist-communicative form of the artist street artist on the street with the recipient the whole society upgrades both the quality of the artist's daily life as an individual (meaning) and the environment in which the act is performed (understanding meaning).
- II. The conceptual identification of Graffiti and Street Art in the digital media (digital city press) influences the public attitude towards Street Art and aids in the stereotypical treatment of artists and the virtual distortion of Street Art works.
- II. The images of the works of the Street Art movement are a daily point of visual and verbal interaction with the passers-by residents visitors from other countries.
- IV. Education with audiovisual tools and learning Street Art techniques inhibits the chances of deviant behavior in minors and young adults (graffiti) by learning in an experiential way the History of Art and the legal path of Street Art (prevention).

Visual Sociology - Criminology: creating a positive meaning of a city through the Art of a Photography

"Street Art Photography"

- Dissemination of images depicting Street Art works worldwide
 - non-existent establishment of rules regarding the photography of Street Art works
- no official recording and scattered material on social media
- depending on the types of works (pieces, paste-up, stencil, mural), a specific photographic imprint is followed illustration of the works, however

"Street Art Hunting"

- Parallelism with "playing" within the city: search for street art works in any area, abandoned and not
- this process offers the feeling of adrenaline and satisfaction of the person who photographs street art works
 - community of street art photographers worldwide
 - monitoring the evolution of the phenomenon and the movement per artist
- highlighting the typology of artists through the repeatability of works in the city

Methodology

combined social science methodology: visual quantitative research and qualitative research with a theoretical influence on Ethnomethodology

Techniques

photography, direct and indirect observation, interviews, digital content analysis - taking "screenshots"


